The Asset Funders Network is seeking a skilled and highly motivated individual to join the organization. The Design & Layout Associate is responsible for ensuring that text, images, and media is in compliance with the AFN style guide and for developing creative layout and graphics to illustrate and enliven asset building content in briefs, advocacy fact sheets, AFN's website, social media, email communications, and marketing of events.

The position reports to the Membership Director in coordination with the Communications Strategist, secondarily reporting to the Managing Director, and generally to the President and CEO.

Primary Objectives (Deliverables)

- Design and Layout coordinate with lead content staff, authors, and communications strategist for assigned briefs or spotlights at the national, regional or projects
- Creative Content Design and graphics as assigned for social media, Conference, webinar series, projects under the supervision of Membership Director and Communications Strategist to engage funders and stakeholders to participate in AFN
- 3. Communications Design Development and Coordination (ensure brand training and adherence, help to identify and choose images across media, develop and finalize communications)
- 4. Provide creative input on strategies to help AFN achieve strategic plan objectives

The employee will be asked to perform some or all of the following objectives and tactics.

Communications - Layout and Design

- 1. Perform as assigned by the supervisor or communications strategist to design and layout briefs, reports, strategy spotlights, and other communications written by experts in the field or AFN staff. This may include:
 - a. editing to final copy process,
 - b. development of creative direction
 - c. providing creative layout and design,
 - d. ensuring layout revisions are incorporated in final,
 - e. conceptualizing the manner to present the brief on the website (not just as a document upload)
 - f. Overseeing layout quality.
- 2. As assigned, design, support or develop eblasts or other event marketing communications.

Biennial National Conference:

Provide support for AFN National Conference including:

- 1. Develop and/or update conference branding
- 2. Design and develop conference sponsorship one pager
- 3. Design or finalize layout of materials (for the conference app) as assigned
- Provide technical assistance support to TechHelp with website, registration or other issues as identified
- 5. Develop eye-catching, creative communications to market the conference

Internal/Build

- 1. Ensure compliance with the AFN style guide for layout and presentation of AFN materials and content.
- 2. Support the maintenance and updating of the style manual
- 3. Adhere to the AFN internal branding protocols
- 4. Follow standards and internal process routines for content to be uploaded on website or sent as an e-blasts in coordination with AFN's Tech Help team.
- 5. Participate in general staff meetings (6-8 a year)
- 6. Support monthly integration and coordination agenda setting and problem solving
- Optional provide backup technical support and/or webinar coordination as needed
- 8. Participate in internal committees as appropriate
