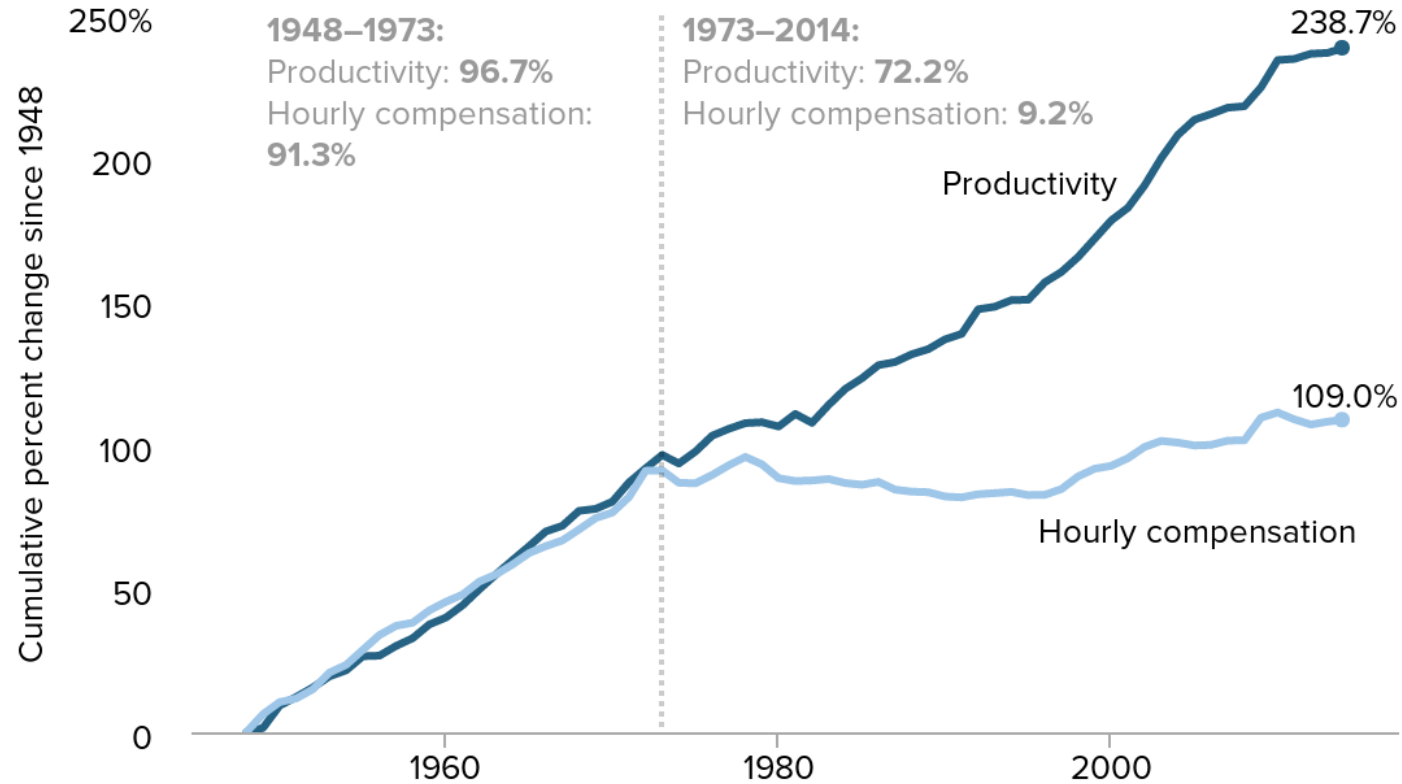

INEQUALITY: A HUGE ISSUE

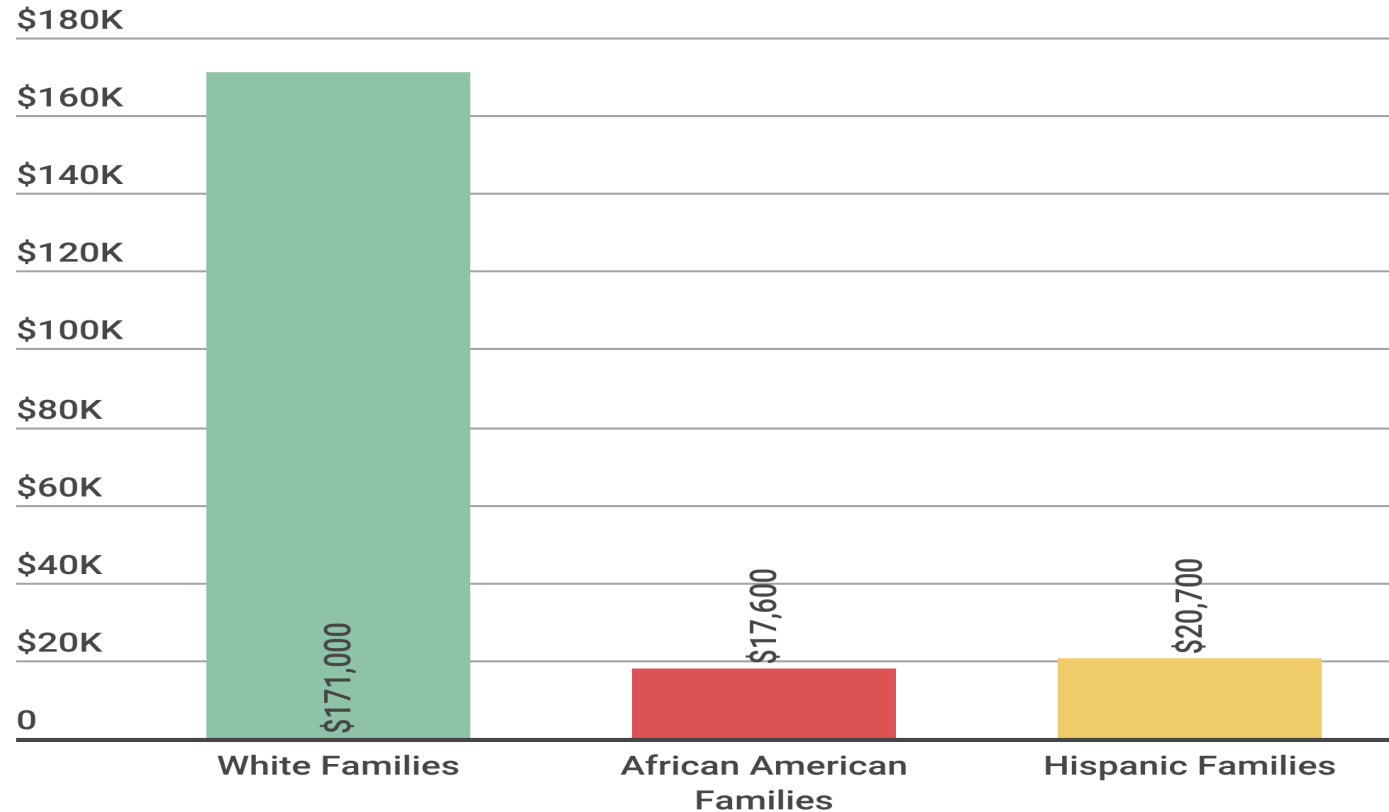
Disconnect between productivity and a typical worker's compensation, 1948–2014



Note: Data are for average hourly compensation of production/nonsupervisory workers in the private sector and net productivity of the total economy. "Net productivity" is the growth of output of goods and services minus depreciation per hour worked.

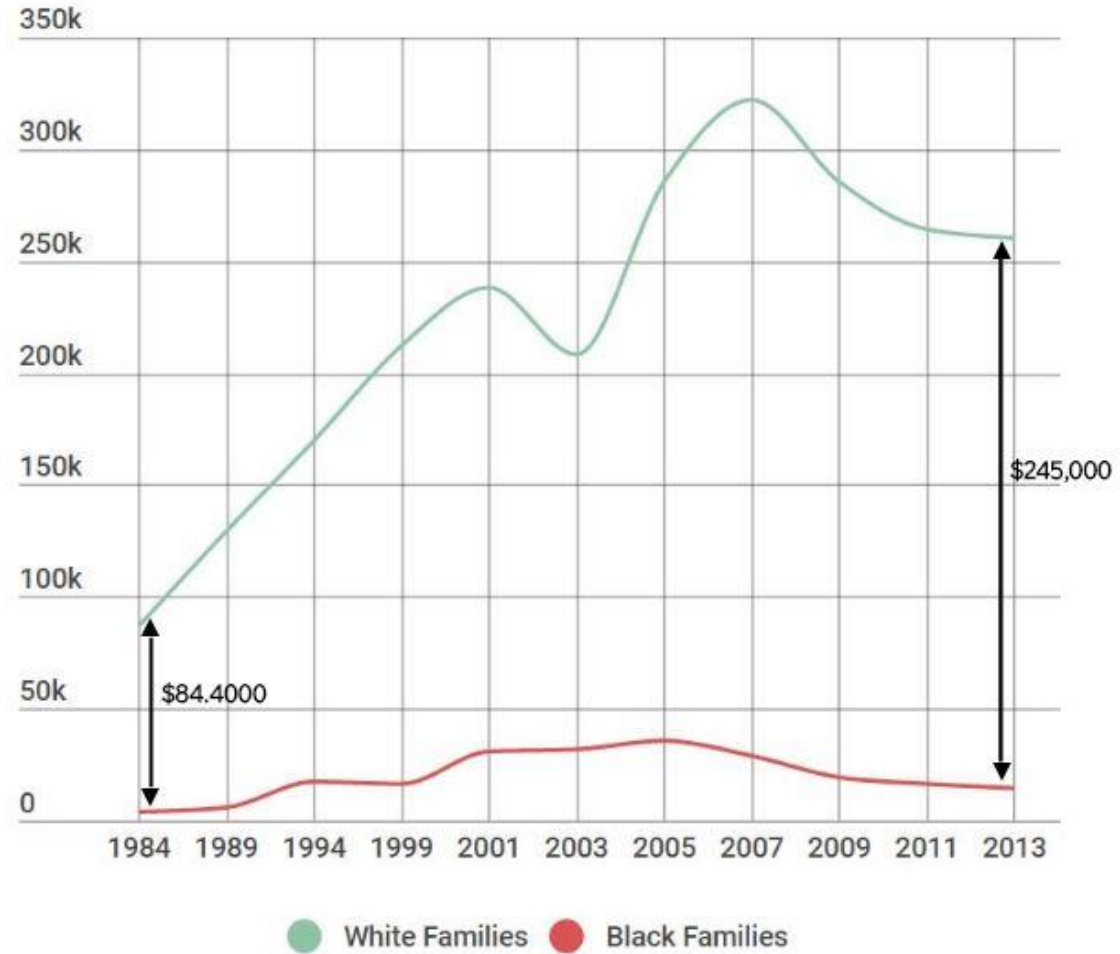

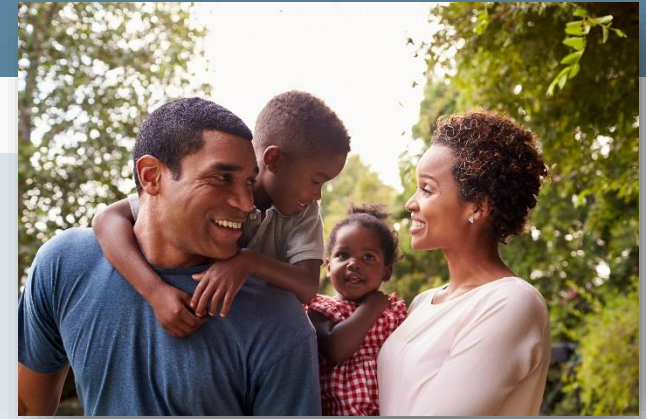

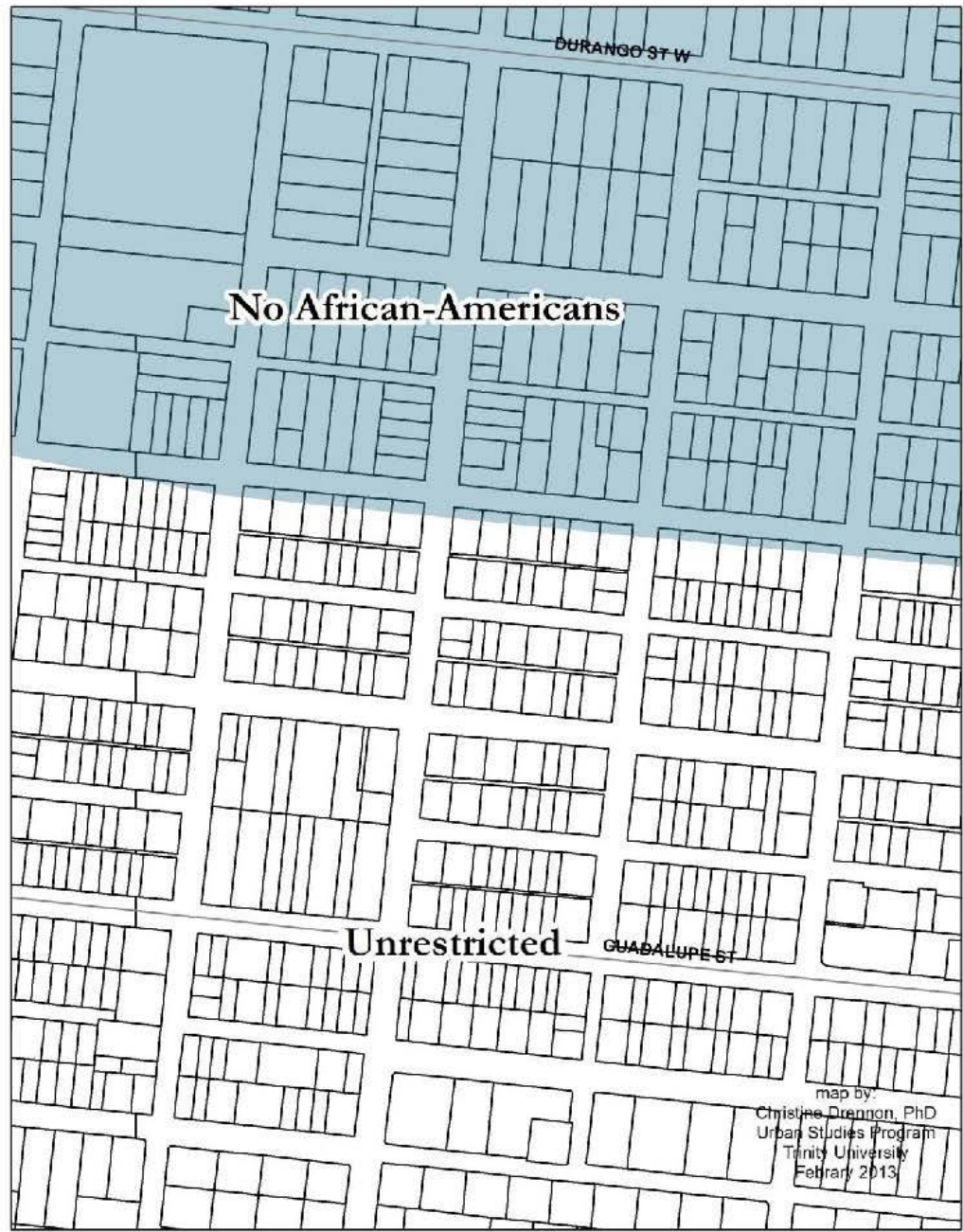

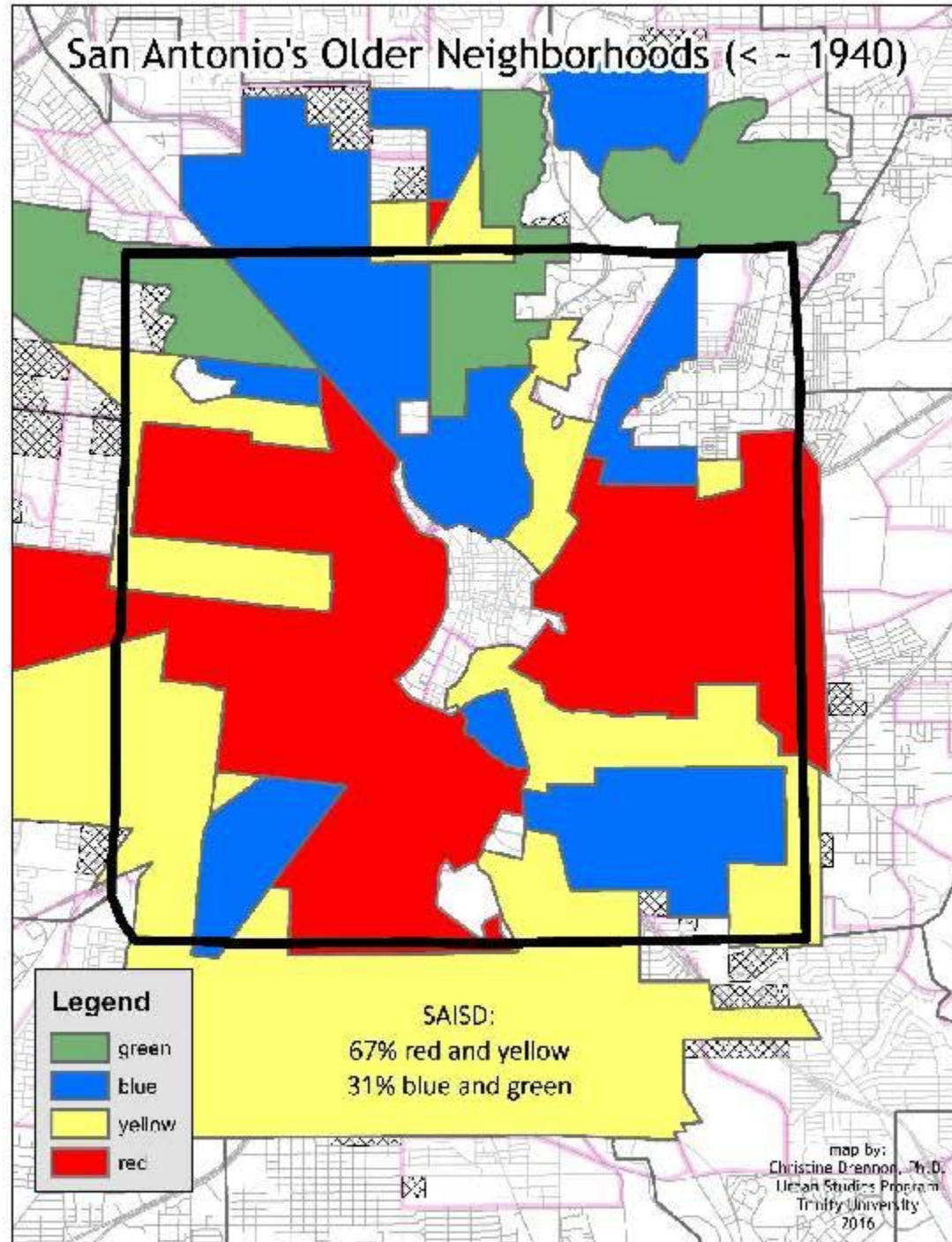

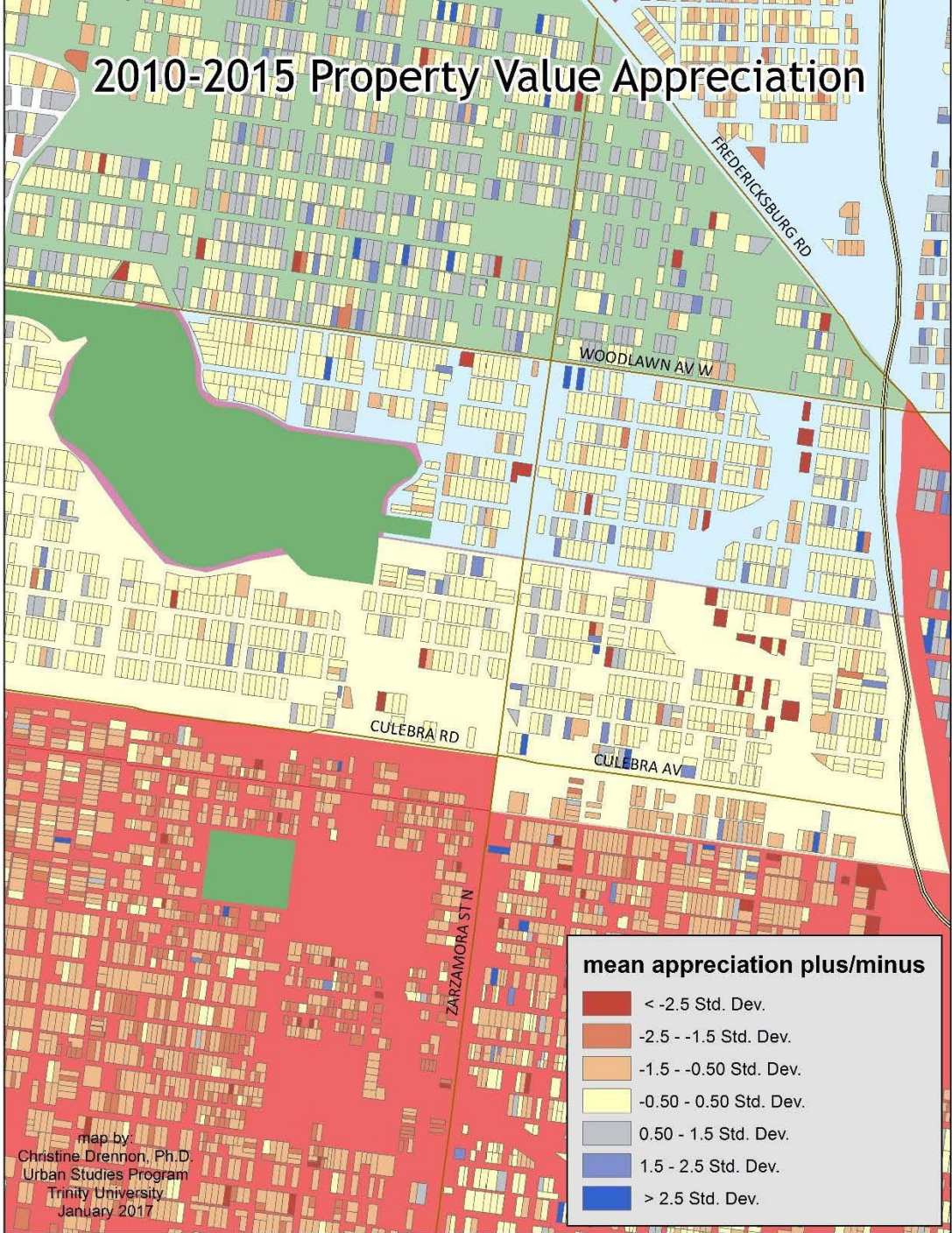
San Antonio's Older Neighborhoods (< ~ 1940)
